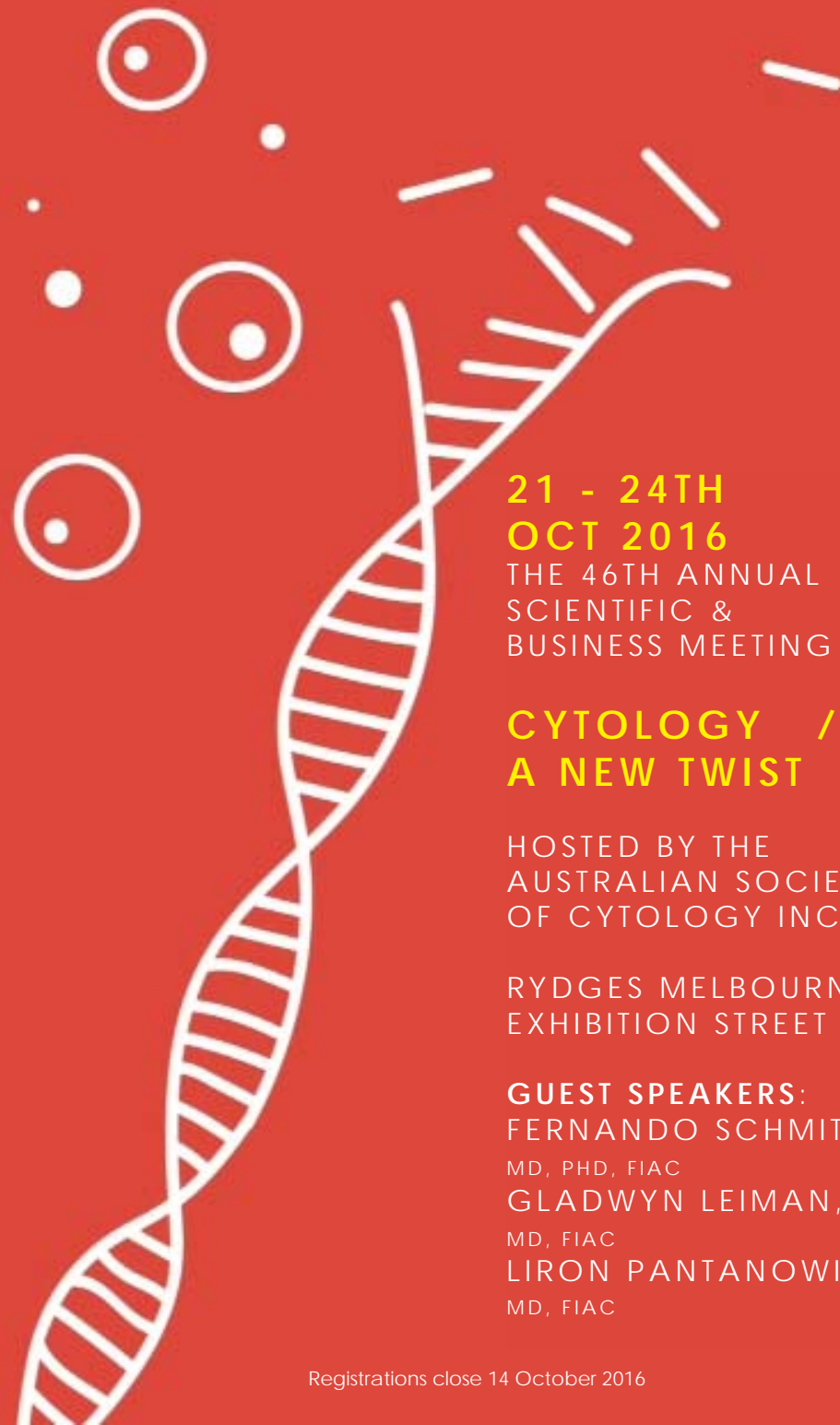

Professor Schmitt is a Professor of Pathology at the University of Porto, senior researcher at IPATIMUP and Director of the Department of Medicine and Pathology at Laboratoire National de Santé in Luxembourg. Professor Schmitt has authored more than 410 papers in peer-review journal, 23 book chapters and two books; he is widely considered a world-leading expert in cytopathology and breast cancer. Currently he is the Secretary-General of the International Academy of Cytology (IAC).



Dr Gladwyn Leiman is a Professor in Pathology at the University of Vermont. She previously was a Director for Cytopathology at the University of Vermont. She has conceived and directed Project Screen Soweto, a plan designed to provide cervical cancer screening services to low-income women of Soweto and pioneered the FNA technique in Johannesburg. She has a bibliography of more than 120 peer reviewed articles and book chapters, serves on the Board of the IAC and is on the editorial boards of many journals.



Dr Liron Pantanowitz is an Associate Professor of Pathology and Associate Professor of Biomedical Informatics at the University of Pittsburgh. He currently serves as the Director of the Informatics Fellowship and Associate Director of the Division of Pathology Informatics at the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center. Dr Pantanowitz is the Editor-in-Chief of the Journal of Pathology Informatics. He is also the chairman of the CAP Pathology Digital Pathology Working Group and president elect of the Association for Pathology Informatics (API).
